

What is a Personal Emergency Response System (PERS)?

PERS is a device which enables participants to secure help in the event of an emergency or urgent concern with 24/7 monitoring and live telephone contact.

Who qualifies for a PERS?

- Participants with the risk factor of living alone
- ❖ Participants who are alone for six (6) or more consecutive hours for three (3) or more days per week

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Offering PERS

Does the participant need to have a land line phone in the home?

A land line phone is not necessary. Some providers offer wireless or cellular units.

Is a Physician Order required?

No, Physician Order is required.

How does a CM authorize PERS?

After identifying a need, the CM will complete the following:

- 1. Ensure PERS is on the SP and complete Prior Approval Justification (1 Unit).
- 2. Using the PERS Provider Choice Form, secure 5 Provider choices.
- 3. Create a referral in Phoenix for PERS (include installation in the note section).
- 4. When notified, approve acceptance of referral.
- 5. Contact Provider and participant to negotiate a start date and create an authorization. (Authorization start date should be the date PERS is installed.)
- 6. Monitor monthly.
